

Dear Students,

I hope that you are enjoying a beautiful summer! At the College of Law, our faculty and staff are busy getting ready for your arrival this fall; we look forward to seeing you!

As was the case last year, in order to access Dineen Hall or any part of the Syracuse University Campus, students, faculty and staff are required to be fully immunized against COVID-19, which means having received both a vaccine and booster, for all who are eligible. The only exception to this requirement is an approved medical or religious exemption. Unvaccinated members of the campus community will be expected to wear a mask at all times on campus (indoors and outdoors).

At this time, in accordance with Syracuse University policy all students must submit your vaccination records to the Student Patient Portal to activate your Student ID, have access to wi-fi, and attend classes and programs in Dineen Hall.

1L residential JD students and new LL.M students – the deadline to submit vaccination records was July 1. If you have not yet submitted your record, please do so as soon as possible in the Patient Portal to avoid holds on your account.

Returning residential JD and LL.M students – you are required to submit your records to the SU Patient Portal by Aug. 1 to allow for adequate processing time. Students who plan to access campus before Aug. 1 must submit their COVID-19 vaccination record prior to accessing campus.
