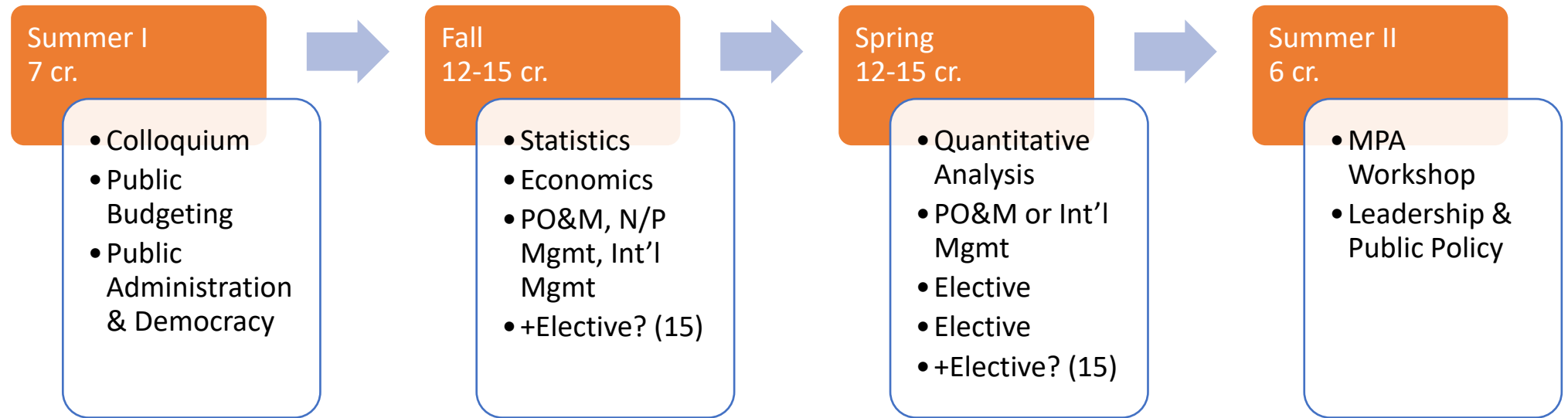

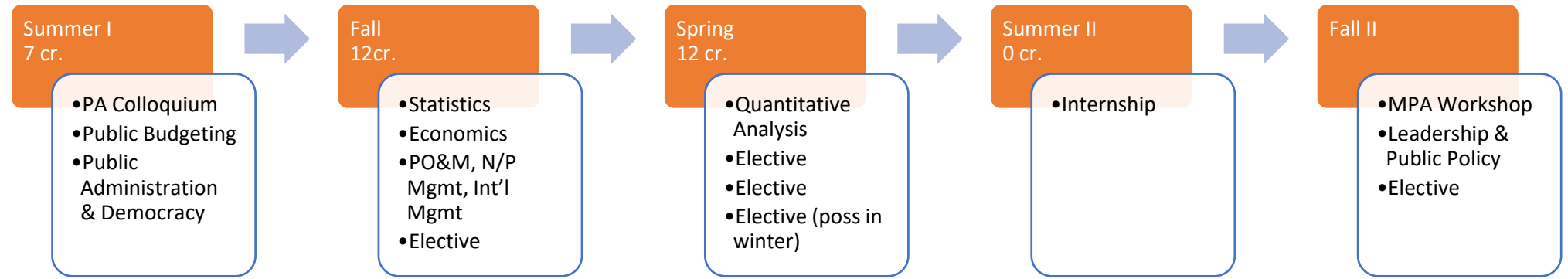

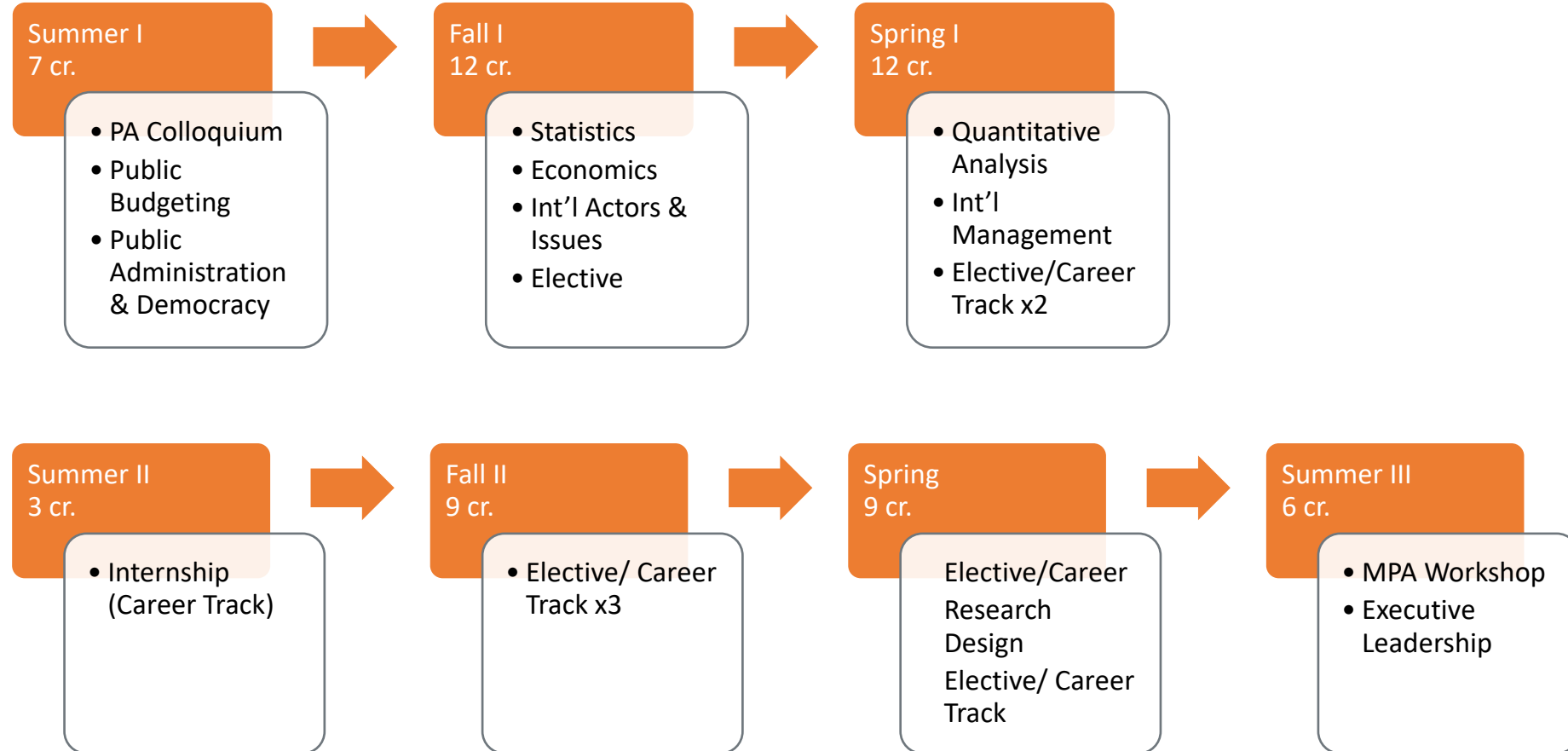
Normal Credit Loads
